- ♦ FRW-Metro has taken on the task of decorating the Republican Party of Bernalillo County float for the NM State Fair parade which occurs on September 12th, Saturday. We have had 2 meetings and have devised a plan to decorate with a large (artificial) 250th birthday cake accompanied by Uncle Sam and President Lincoln. Thus far we've explored options for creating the cake and will move forward when the best idea presents itself. Logistical issues remain to be worked out.
