Contested Republican NM HD60 candidates Josh Hernandez and Zac Anaya spoke to us as well as two Sandoval County Commission candidates Dan Stoddard and Paul Llinson. Ramona Goolsby, candidate for NM Secretary of State was a speaker, too. Daphne Orner, RPBC Chair, and Beth Dowling, RPSC Chair, keep us informed on the county news and activities! Bobbi Curtis invited us to AFP trainings, Constitution classes and ABQ City Council meetings with controversial issues for public comment.
