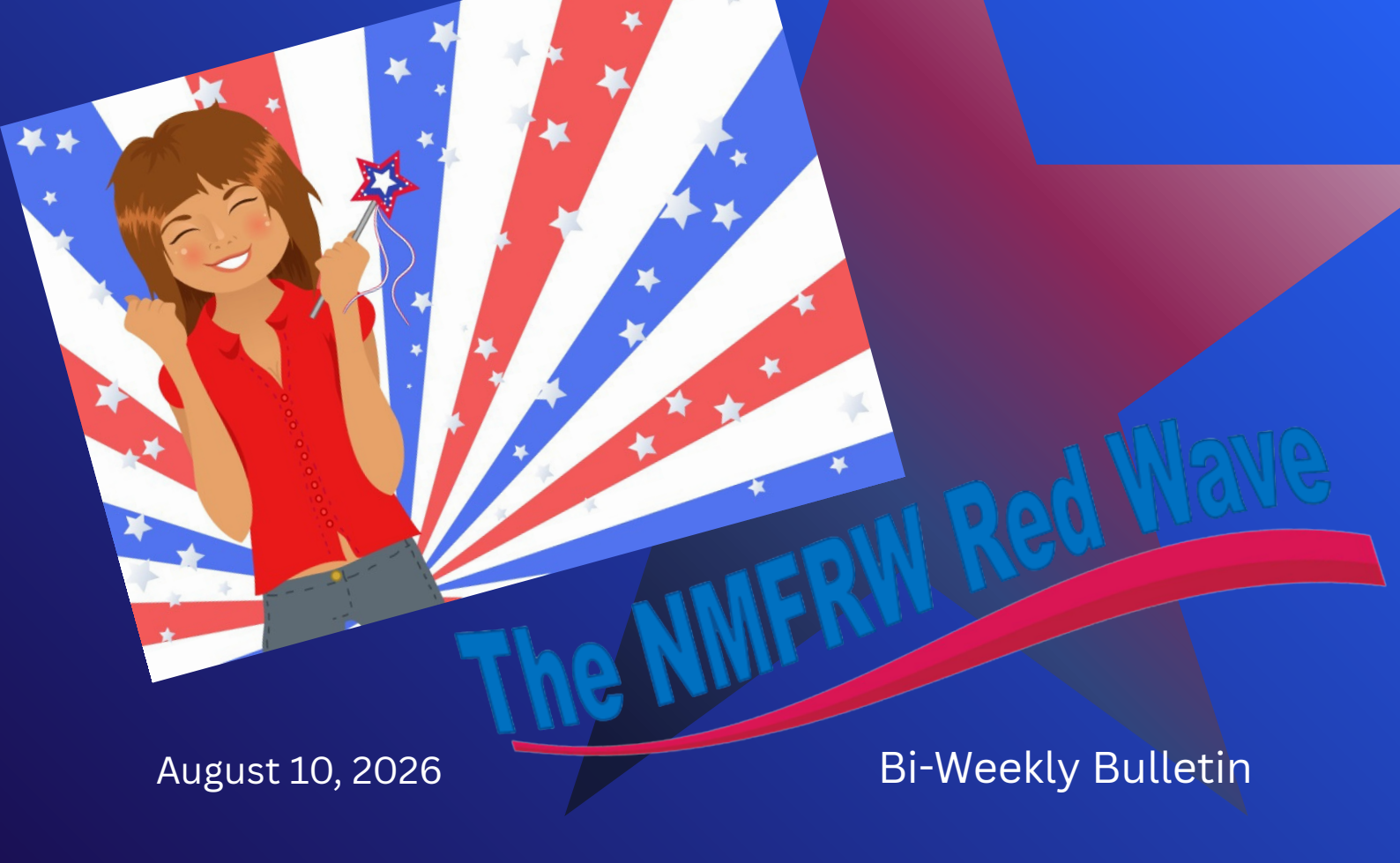

Presidents Report

Our Summer meeting was a great success. Anita set us up with Bishop Augustine on Friday night who celebrated 50 years in ministry in May 2026. He began first as a church planter in 1997 organizing a mission church in Islamabad, Pakistan. He presented a discussion on Islam and why Muslims are entering American politics. He was consecrated as a Bishop in 2019 in St. Andres Cathedral in the Episcopal Diocese of Bor, South Sudan where his ministry continues. On Saturday the Leadership Institute presented an informative training on women in leadership including a session on Roberts Rules.

In March, at the National Meeting, we spent a day on capital hill listening to our Congressmen and Women. Through meetings and networking sessions with leaders from around the country and National Committee Chairs we discussed action plans and ideas for the year.

At the national as well as the state level, Membership has been a consistent topic as more hands help shape the nation.

Ramona Goolsby

Candidate for New Mexico Secretary of State

Since settling in New Mexico, Ramona has thrown herself into public life. She sponsored all six referendum bills in New Mexico and served as designated agent for HB7, SB13, and SB180. She has partnered with nonprofits and advocacy organizations working on election integrity, constitutional rights, and community education across the state.

Ramona believes elections should bring people together, not divide them. When she saw transparency concerns go unanswered, she acted: filing a lawsuit in the 13th District Court challenging constitutional violations by the Secretary of State's office, a Writ of Mandamus to obtain 2022 election ballots, and multiple ethics complaints with the State Ethics Commission.

Faith in God, love for her family, and a commitment to America's founding ideals are the foundation of everything Ramona does. She is asking for the honor of serving all of New Mexico without fear, without favor, and with integrity.

As members of NFRW, we are already women of influence.

Our founder, Marion Martin, was the original Woman of Influence—leading with vision, inspiring others to join her, and building a movement that continues today.

We join NFRW to make a difference—to influence elections, strengthen our communities, and help shape the future of our nation.
